

Admission to B. Pharm. (First Semester), 2020-21

Instructions for the shortlisted candidates (IIIrd Merit List)

The last date to deposit the admission/ course fee for admission to B. Pharm. first year is 18 November 2020.

1. All the shortlisted candidates in the merit list have been recommended for provisional admissions only in the first year of B. Pharm. course. The merit list is based on the application forms and the documents uploaded to the admission portal. However, a physical verification of documents will be carried out, once the university is opened for students to be physically present.
2. All provisionally admitted students in B.Pharm I sem. must produce their original documents, High School Certificate, Intermediate (12th) Mark-sheet, Certificate of Reservation Category (if applicable), and address proof, to the Admission Committee. Final admissions to B. Pharm course will be confirmed only after the successful physical verification of documents by the candidate. Also, at the time of verification, the candidate will have to submit their original TC/CC/Migration certificate along with a signed copy of the online application form.
3. In case of the failure to produce the original documents, as described above, the admission of such candidates will stand cancelled, and the deposited fee will be reimbursed as per the university norms.
4. The last date to deposit the admission/ course fee for admission to B. Pharm. first year is **18 November 2020**. It is compulsory to deposit the admission/ course fee on or before the due date, otherwise, the candidature of such shortlisted candidates will be cancelled.
5. The shortlisted candidates can log onto the university admission portal's website <https://online.hnbgau.ac.in/preadd20/> using their registered ID and password. A link for the online payment of admission fee, for the admission to B. Pharm. first year, will be visible once you have logged onto the admission website portal. A breakup of the admission/ course fee (excluding examination fee) for B. Pharm. is as follows:

Tuition Fee (Annual)	Rs. 32000=00
Caution Money (refunded after the completion of the course)	Rs. 5,000=00
DSW Fee	Rs. 410=00
Total Fee (to be deposited at the time of admission)	Rs. 37,410=00 (Rupee Thirty Seven Thousand, Four Hundred and Ten)

6. For the hostel accommodation, the admitted students can regularly check university website and need to apply, separately.
